Local project: Majblomman / Swedish organization working to combat child poverty.

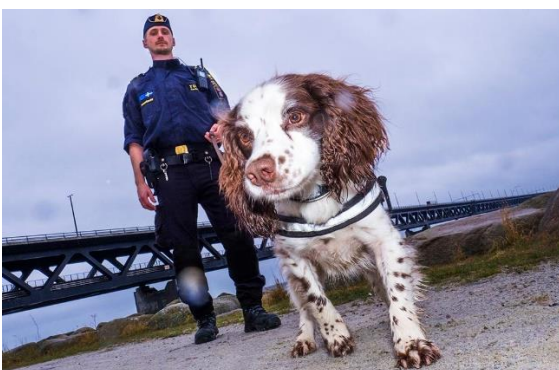
National project: Support to the training of dogs supporting customs police to track drugs.
