Through Angelika Walde's initiative and Gemma Pirondini's combined efforts and your utmost support and generosity, the Swiss bank account was able to sustain substantial donations to two destroyed hospitals in the area.*

*Through your contributions, we were able to buy them medical equipment of a value exceeding 55'000 \$, equipment they were in dire need of.*

*Once all equipment was delivered, we organized a small reception in both hospitals, to celebrate the joy of having been able to lend a hand.
